6:30pm Rob Henry gave a presentation on swarms. Some causes of swarms are not enough room in the hive and poor ventilation. Look for swarm cells now. If the bees are crowded, they could be making plans to swarm. The swarm cells (supercedure cell) look like a peanut on the bottom of the frame. If you see these, your hive is preparing to swarm. You can add more clean frames or another super to give them more room to work. You may want to get an extra box ready to catch the swarm if they do swarm.
